JAPFÜ CHRISTIAN COLLEGE (JCC) is accredited by NAAC with B⁺ grade, imparting God-fearing quality education for all-round development of students. The college was inaugurated on July 5th, 1996. It is a residential co-educational institute offering Arts stream at the Secondary and Undergraduates' level. "The College being an extended ministry of **JBCC** is sponsored by the 14 Churches and will in principle, uphold the virtues of Christian faith as its foundation and therefore be under the control of JBCC". The **First Sunday** of June is **JCC Prayer Day** where the college and all sponsoring Churches pray for Japfü Christian College. Two sponsoring churches are visited annually by JCC E.U/EGF/BOM/Staff. The rotating schedule is included in JBCC Annual Calendar.

JCC is located within the Mission Centre of Japfüphiki Baptist Church Council (JBCC) at Kipfüzha, 12 kms south of the capital city, Kohima. Nestled in the foothills of the majestic Japfü Mountain, the college exists in perfect harmony with the rich natural surroundings enveloping it. The College environment provides ideal atmosphere for students' **Academic, Spiritual** and **Physical** developments. The college is equipped with state of the art infrastructures and equipments, manned by faculty and office staff that are highly qualified and dedicated in pursuance of its vision and mission.

BOARD OF MANAGEMENT (BOM)

JBCC constitutes the BOM, but the board "remains autonomous in its function and administration, empowered to carry out all activities without any interference except on policy matters".

GOAL

Believing in the maxim, “Education is not an end in itself but a means to an end”, JCC has all-round development as its goal; that includes Academic, Spiritual and Physical excellences.

ACADEMIC

JCC aims to provide decent education. The college follows certain principles to guide academic management such as: “Recruit highly qualified academicians to teach”, “Every paper every day” as far as practicable, “more tests and exams for better results”, “Rewarding students who excel in studies”.

SPIRITUAL

Development of student spirituality and moral character is part and parcel in the “all-round development”. PHYSICAL

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PAYMENT OF FEES FOR CLASS XI & XII

Installments

The fees to be paid in installments are Tuition Fee and Room Rent.

1. The First Installment and annual fees are to be paid at the time of admission.
2. The Second Installment is to be paid in the month of September or as notified
3. Hostel Room Rent will be taken in full for 12 months irrespective of occupancy.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PAYMENT OF FEES FOR SEMESTER SYSTEM

Installments

The fees to be paid in two equal installments for semester system are Tuition Fee and Room Rent.

1. The First Installment is to be paid at the time of admission.
2. The Second Installment is to be paid after three months of admission or as notified.

- * *Fee payment notice may be served for total clearance prior to internal/external exams.*
- * *Non-payment of fees will result in with-holding of Admit Cards/Results/Mark sheets of College/NU/NBSE.*
- * *Hostel Room Rent will be taken in full for 6 months for Semester irrespective of occupancy.*

ANNUAL FEES

1. Pay the Annual Fees in full at the time of admission.
2. No admissions shall be allowed, under any circumstances, without full clearance of Annual Fees.

COLLEGE UNIFORM

1. White Shirt/Black Pants/Black Socks/ Black Formal Shoes/ College Necktie, Badge & Muffler (Monday–Thursday).
*College T. Shirts/Class Hoodies, if available, can wear on Wednesdays with college blazer/black pants/black socks/black formal shoes.
2. Cultural Fridays: Any decent attire with a Traditional touch: Minimum traditional Tribal Stoles/conspicuous tribal necklaces/headgears.

MESS FEE

1. Pay the full month's Mess Fee at the time of admission/Arrival. Balance, if any, are adjusted at course end or as notified by Mess management.
2. Pay each month's Mess Fee before 10th of every month, failing which a fine of ₹10/- (Ten) only shall be charged for every defaulting day. Legal Parents / Guardian to notify authority in case of genuine problems.
3. Mess Fee advance payment notice may be served for total clearance prior to internal/ external exams.
4. Non-payment of Mess Fees for 2 consecutive months will invite Parents/Guardians' Call.

FREE STUDENTSHIP

1. College offers free studentship to select students from economically disadvantaged Families/ differently-abled students/JCC Staff & Faculty's, JBCC Full time Ministry Workers' children by waiving Tuition fee/Room rent.
2. Free studentship is extended to one member if three or more students are from the same family.

REFUNDING RULES

General

1. Annual Fees shall not be refunded after Admission.
2. Students will need to take blazer measurement on time. Blazer money is not refundable as it is collected and handed over to tailors.
3. Cancellation of Admission before commencement of Classes shall be refunded the First Installment.
4. After the commencement of Classes the First Installment shall not be refunded.
5. After July, there will be no refunding of second installment for Class XI & XII.
6. After the commencement of class, there shall be no refunding of second installment for semester system.
7. Computer Fees will not be refunded /waived after the last day of admission.

Mess Fee

1. No refunding of Mess Fee for late coming under normal circumstances. But if late coming is due to any extraordinary reasons like own hospitalization, death of immediate family member or much publicized roadblocks, the same should be reported to the Principal/Vice Principal in writing for decision.
2. If a hosteller is permitted leave 8 or more days by the Resident Officer concerned, the grantee shall be refunded daily Mess Fee of ₹50/- per day provided the application is forwarded by the Resident Officer and duly approved by the Principal.

3. Mess Fees during arrivals/departures/ Exam Days are fixed as:

- i. 1-4 Days : ₹300/-
- ii. 5-7 Days : ₹500/-
- iii. 8-15 Days : ₹1000/-
- iv. 16-19 Days : ₹1400/-
- v. 20-31 Days : ₹2000/-



COLLEGE RULES

A. Offences leading to expulsion from the College

9. Evidential Malpractice in Examinations.
10. Union(s) formation without college permission or taking harmful issues to the media without prior written permission from Principal.
11. Violation of Kigwema village rules, especially on Forest Fire related issues.
12. Cyber Crime: Harmful/Indecent SMS/FB/Whatsapp/Instagram posting/Morphing etc.
13. Physical assault on fellow students.
14. Violation of college rules after Last Warning.
15. Last Day Misbehaviour by any students will be remarked in their Transfer Certificate/Cumulative Certificate/Character Certificate. Documents will be handed over only to parents/legal guardian after formal apology by the erring student.
16. Any other serious misbehavior deserving expulsion.

B. Offences for not permitting students to return to College

C. Offences leading to Warning: College/Hostel

1. Missing Class without permission from appropriate authorities, after 5th verbal warning.
2. Entering Dormitory of the opposite sex.
3. Repeated use of mobile phones/ laptops/tablets etc., during inappropriate times (item will also be confiscated).
*Appropriate authorities can view set contents.
4. Repeated Writing/Painting/Pasting/Staining/Nailing on concrete Walls.
5. Long Hair (boys)
6. Coloured Hair Dyes (Unisex), with exception to black & earthy browns.
7. Repeated non-attendance of Chapel/Activities of College.
8. Frequent payment of different categories of fines.

9. Repeated non-wearing of College Blazer/ Tee Shirt as instructed. Only Blazer is allowed to be worn on top of college Tee shirt.
10. Any other serious mis-behaviour.

D. Offences leading to Fine: College/Hostel (Each Catch)

1. Nailing, pasting, staining/writing on concrete walls & furniture. [₹20]
2. Staining Class Rooms/Corridors if unidentified: [Repaid/ Re-paint by Class]
3. Sleeping during Study hours/ Sharing of bed. [₹10]
4. Not speaking English. [₹10]
5. Disturbing study hours/Visiting other's room. [₹10]
6. Inappropriate use of mobile phones/laptops (confiscation 1m/2m/Semester End).
7. Crossing Boundary fencing without using College Main Gate. (₹200)
8. Use of heavy appliances like Iron Press, Room Heater, Immersion Rod etc. (₹500)
9. Sneaking out on non-outing days. [₹100/ Warning/ Not to return consecutively]
10. Use of tobacco products in any form. [₹20]
11. Having food in Hostel room without permission. (₹50)
12. Breaking small window panes (intentional/ Unintentional). (₹50)
13. Breaking big window panes (intentional/Unintentional). (₹100)
14. Non-wearing of Uniform (₹50 per day: Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday (T.S), Thursday)
15. Late Submission of Library Books (₹10 per day).

16. Late arrival for Hostel: (₹200)
 17. Late arrival for Class: (₹200)
 18. Non-submission of mobile phones by Class XI & XII
 19. During Selection/Final Examinations: (₹200).
- Seized phones will be released after examinations

NB.

- a. Permission for use of keyboards, laptops, etc., involves ₹100 for a year and using without permission involves a fine of ₹100/- per catch.
- b. Appropriate college authorities are allowed to view mobile set/laptop contents.
- c. Hostel seats are given to students who agree to follow all rules, norms and activities of the Hostel/ College.
- d. BA 5th Semester /6th Semester Hostellers are to compulsorily take Computer Course (Diploma), except those already qualified. (@₹4000/-)

E. Attendance, Examination & Admission Rules

1. A minimum of 80% attendance being mandatory, defaulting students shall not be permitted to write Promotion/Selection/ Final Examination, except when granted.
2. Non-attendance of coaching classes/Non Payment of Fees/Dues/Non-submission of Assignments/ Remedial Coaching Class/ Negligence of Internal Exams; will lead to with-holding of Admit Cards (Selection, Final exams), debarring the defaulting candidate from appearing the College/ NU/ NBSE exam.
3. Any serious misbehavior by students during exam period will disqualify his/her candidature or even non-issuance of Mark sheet/ Result/Transfer Certificate.
4. Class XI & XII are to compulsorily take the 5th Subject as per NBSE guidelines. Entry into Class XI is HSLC Passed candidates.
5. Failed students, as per NU Semester examination rules, will take admission/ appear examination at their own risk (s).

6. BA Semester students not securing minimum qualifying marks in the **Internal Marks (14 Marks)** will not be allowed to write exam, as per NU Rules.
7. BA Semester students not securing minimum qualifying marks in the **External Marks (32 Marks)** will be declared failed, as per NU Rules.
8. Risks Admissions are taken for BA Semester classes even prior to the declaration of NU Results so as to increase working days.
9. As per NU Rules; admission to the next semester shall be permitted only with a minimum of **Two Backlog** papers from the preceding semester.
10. Admissions to **4th semester** are disallowed to students with **First Semester Backlog**.
11. Admissions to **5th semester** are disallowed to students with **Second Semester Backlog**.
12. Admissions to **6th semester** are disallowed to students with **Third Semester Backlog**.
13. 4th semester Backlog can be repeated along with 6th semester.
14. Backlog paper(s) of 5th & 6th semesters need to be cleared during subsequent examinations for these semesters within 10 Semesters with a maximum of only one chance (NU).
15. Expelled Students having cleared all 3rd/4th Semesters will be allowed to write their 1st/2nd backlog papers on humanitarian ground.
16. 6th Semester Students neglecting **Internal Exams** will not be allowed to write **End Semester Exam**.

HOSTEL RULES

A. Offences leading to Expulsion from Hostel

1. Gambling (any game involving money)
2. Use of intoxicating Drinks.
3. Overnight without permission.
4. Any other misbehavior deserving expulsion.

B. Offences leading to *Not to Return to College* Category

1. Leaving hostel permanently without proper written permission without the consent and physical presence of both Parents/Guardians and concerned Resident Officer will fall under “not to return to college” category.
2. Indifference to warnings.

C. Offences leading to Warning

1. Playing cards.
2. Not speaking English even after repeated verbal warnings & fines.
3. Continuation of bad habits even after repeated verbal warnings & fines.
4. Possessing pornographic materials in any form.
5. Frequent escaping Social Works/Visiting other's room during study hours [Double work/ Triple work/ Warning]
6. Tampering of granted leave letters.
7. Any other misbehavior that deserves warning.
